



# CURRICULUM AND MATERIALS

## LANGUAGE AND LITERACY

Introduce the beginning skills needed for Phonemic Awareness and Basic Reading, focusing on letter recognition, sound association, alliteration and rhyme

Aligned to the three-year-old Birth to Five Year national standards

## MATH

Differentiated, center-based, and small group activities integrated across the curriculum focusing on number identification, one-to-one correspondence, colors, shapes, patterns, and measurement

Aligned to the three-year-old Birth to Five Year national standards

## RELIGION

Units follow a grade level-thematic curriculum aligned to the church calendar year.

Supplemented with various Catholic-based websites/Catholic ABC's activities by Lacy Rabideau - taught in class by classroom teacher.

Students will begin to develop a love for Christ, develop a love for Blessed Mother Mary, and begin to learn simple prayers

## SOCIAL EMOTIONAL

Focus on Autonomy, forming positive relationships with peers and teachers, managing classroom transition and events, expressing ideas and feelings, displaying empathy towards fellow peers, and succeeding in school

## ASSESSMENTS

Report Cards denote mastery of skills as Exceeding, Proficient, Developing, Needs Improvement (checklist/narrative)

## SCHEDULE

Students attend school 7:25am - 3:25pm Monday through Friday (full-time program)

Recess, Lunch, Snacks, and Nap scheduled daily

Art, Music, and Library will be integrated as the program develops
