



CURRICULUM AND MATERIALS

READING

McGraw-Hill *Wonders* - Reading/Writing Workshop and Literature Anthology (follows LA State ELA standards)

Writing in Response to Literature, Vocabulary aligned with *Wonders* series

One Reading teacher per grade, with a Resource Teacher available 2-3 times weekly for last 30 minutes of each block

WRITING LAB

Supplemental Mercy Writing Curriculum, aligned with LA Writing Standards and ACT Aspire Writing rubrics

Sadlier *Grammar Workshop* for explicit grammar/mechanics instruction

MATH

Pearson *Envision 2.0 Math (2016)* - aligned to common core Math standards

One Math teacher per grade, with a Resource Teacher available 2-3 times weekly for last 30 minutes of each block

SCIENCE (departmentalized with Social Studies)

McGraw-Hill *Science: A Closer Look* - follows NGSS standards

Half-year curriculum, alternates nine-week periods with Social Studies

SOCIAL STUDIES (departmentalized with Science)

McGraw-Hill *Discovering Our Past: United States History*

Half-year curriculum, alternates nine-week periods with Science

RELIGION

Sadlier *We Believe* - taught as core course by certified Religion teacher, 30 minutes set schedule daily

ENRICHMENTS

P.E. - 30 minutes, twice weekly (Gym)

Library - 30 minutes, once weekly (Library)

Music - 40 minutes every other day: Choir, Band, or Fine Arts Survey, selected by students (Music or Band rooms)



Art - 40 minutes every other day, alternating with selected Music course for one nine weeks (Art room)

Spanish - 40 minutes every other day, alternating with selected Music course for one nine weeks (Room 5-2)

Computer - 40 minutes every other day, alternating with selected Music course for one nine weeks (Computer Lab)

Study Skills - 40 minutes every other day, alternating with selected Music course for one nine weeks (Room 5-1)
