**Dear Parents,**

**Here are a few things we thought you might want to know about Living Rosary. Please bring your rosaries and follow along with us as your children will lead us in this wonderful prayer. Seats will be available for you in the front of church.**

- I. Dress**
  - Boys and Girls will wear school dress uniform, including blazer.**
  
- II. Parent Brunch**
  - A. Children will come back in church after Rosary to take you down to brunch.**
  - B. Walk down to the gym.**
  - C. Sit with children at tables. Children will head back to class at ~10:20 [3<sup>rd</sup> hour class]**
  - D. We will follow our regular schedule for the remainder of the school day.**
  
- III. Other reminders for kids:**
  - A. Eat breakfast!!! You need your energy!!!!**
  - B. Come dressed and ready for morning assembly.**

**Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup>**

**STUDENTS: DAY'S SCHEDULE:**

**Arrival: as usual**

Come dressed ready for the Rosary- Dress Uniform including blazer

**8:05- 8:25**

**Go to 1<sup>st</sup> hour -----office will call you to go to Mrs. Galliano's room**

**8:30- 8:45**

Line up and walk to church

**8:50-9:25**

**Service**

- a. Readers and Choir go in first- sit in choir area
- b. Rosary- line up in order
- c. Meet your partner at end of pews
- d. Pick up candle.
- e. Walk slowly to your spot. After service,
- f. Walk out with partner—
  - i. blow out candle about half way down aisle
  - ii. place in basket
  - iii. exit to the church courtyard area and wait for other students to leave church
  - iv. when instructed, meet your parents on front steps of church
  - v. escort your parent/s to the gym; sit with them for brunch!

**9:30**

**Brunch**

1. welcome and opening prayer and pledge
2. blessing
3. serve your parents, eat and talk to your parents

**10:20**

1. tell parents goodbye
2. resume schedule- report to 3<sup>rd</sup> hour

**Other reminders:**

1. Eat breakfast!!! You need your energy!!!!
2. Come dressed and ready.
3. During the ceremony:
  - a. Say the prayers with the students and readers.
  - b. Do not tip or lean candle once it is lit.
  - c. If candle goes out, relight with neighbor's candle.
  - d. Do not lock your knees; bend them a little
  - e. ALWAYS be respectful and prayerful.
4. You will miss part of 1<sup>st</sup> hour, all of 2<sup>nd</sup> hour, and part of 3<sup>rd</sup> hour. You will attend the full 4<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> hour classes.
