



# CURRICULUM AND MATERIALS

## ENGLISH / LANGUAGE ARTS

Two 50-minute blocks daily, taught by a departmentalized ELA teacher, with an Honors class option

McDougal Littel *Literature* , Holt *Elements of Language* , Sadlier *Grammar for Writing*, and *The Latin and Greek Roots Challenge Vocabulary Program*

STAR Reading and Accelerated Reader used for independent reading and Novel Studies

## MATH

One 50-minute block, taught by a departmentalized Math teacher, with Honors and Accelerated options, including courses for High School credit

Pearson *Envision 2.0 Math (2016)* - aligned to common core Math standards

## SCIENCE

One 50-minute block, taught by a departmentalized Science teacher

McGraw-Hill/Glencoe *Science: A Closer Look* Physical Science (6<sup>th</sup> grade), Life Science (7<sup>th</sup> Grade) and Earth Science (8<sup>th</sup> Grade) - follows NGSS standards

## SOCIAL STUDIES

One 50-minute block, taught by a departmentalized Social Studies teacher

McGraw-Hill *Discovering Our Past: History of the World* (6<sup>th</sup> Grade), McGraw-Hill *Discovering Our Past: United States History* (7<sup>th</sup> Grade), Clairmont Press *Louisiana History* (8<sup>th</sup> Grade)

## RELIGION

One 50-minute block, taught by a departmentalized Religion teacher

## ELECTIVES

Two 50-minute courses, alternating daily, selected by students for the year
