



Kidcam Camp is excited to return to OLOM this summer! The camp is open to OLOM families - both for the school and the parish. The camp will be held on the OLOM campus. OLOM is a private Kidcam camp - meaning only OLOM families can register. The information is on our main page - kidcamcamp.com However - when you register - you must choose the Region: OLOM Baton Rouge. Do not choose "Baton Rouge". This is how we try to keep only OLOM families registering for this location.

We have a GREAT camp program, and we would love for you to join us this spring break and summer!

A bit about our program... We have been around for over 40 years! We are a family of educators who know there is a need for fun when the kids are out of school!

What makes our program unique:

- Hands-on Activity-based Programs - include, but are not limited to: science experiments, arts and crafts, field trips, swimming and splash days, water activity days, talent shows, special guests, games of all kinds and much more! But our interactions are what really set us apart! We do not just "watch kids" - we believe in a fun, interactive experience where our staff participates with the campers, and the campers LOVE IT!
- Planned curriculum - To provide a hands-on, engaging camp every week!
- Fun AND Learning! - We incorporate every fun thing we can think of into our summer program and we sprinkle in the learning. The campers are having so much fun, they don't even realize they are learning new information and skills!
- Open Door - We know we are not perfect, but we do our best to keep the lines of communication open! Please do not hesitate if you have any concerns - tell us right away so we can address them!
- Communication - We send out a newsletter every week during the summer so that you know what is coming up for the next week!
- Smiles! - Your child will be greeted each day with a smile! If not - let us know - our mission is to provide a safe, happy place for your child to create lifetime camp memories!
- Camper Interactions - We keep a 10:1 ratio to make sure that we can safely monitor your child and interact with all the children all day!
- Training - We train all of our staff in safety, positive discipline, positive interactions and much more!

- Great Staff - We hire both adults and youth - adults give guidance and have great experience....the youth bring a zest and fun that the campers love!

Some details that you may want to know about:

- Camp dates are May 29 - July 27. However, we have other locations open until Aug 3 - you can transfer for the last week without paying an additional registration fee.
- Campers - Ages 3-13.
- Campers are divided into school-aged groups so that the activities are age-appropriate. Your child will be placed by school cohort, not calendar year age.
- Food
 - Breakfast & Lunch Provided by Food Grant - (we have been told we have it for the summer. There is always a chance that can fall through, but it looks good for now! Should it fall through, we provide meals for purchase.) You can send lunch if you prefer or if your child has allergies.
 - Please realize that children are very active at Kidcam and get much hungrier than during the school year, so they may eat more food than you send if you pack a lunch. No peanuts or peanut butter items, please.
 - Snack Program - \$2/snack for afternoon snack - you can send one if you prefer, but each camper **MUST** have a snack. If you do not send one or if your child eats it before snack time, your child will receive a snack, and your account will be charged.
 - Aftercare Snack - \$2 per snack - if your child will be staying past 4pm, you can send or buy another snack. If you do not send one or if your child eats it before aftercare snack time, your child will receive a snack and your account will be charged.
- Flexible Planning - Whole Summer or One Week at a Time!
 - Best prices are for the full summer - 20% discount! (already figured in the price online)
 - 10% Discounts when paying for 3 or more weeks in your cart at one time.
 - Individual weeks - additional siblings are 10% off.
- Hours - 7am - 6pm in the summer (7:30 - 5:30 for Spring Break).
 - 7-9am is a free choice Before-Care time. No additional charge for before care.
 - 9-3 is our structured "camp day" - with planned, organized activities (see the attached schedule for a sample schedule).
 - 3-6 is Aftercare - there is an additional charge for aftercare, \$2/half hour for the first child and \$1/half hour for each additional child. You only pay for what you use. You do not have to tell us in advance if you plan to use it each day.
 - Spring Break there is no aftercare fee – the price includes the full day.
- Swimming -
 - Swimming will be held at Village St. George in the summer (we do not swim for spring break.)
 - Certified life guards on duty.
 - Staff members not only go to the pool - they also must get IN the pool to keep campers safe.

- Campers who cannot pass the swim test must wear a life vest at the pool. Campers do not have to take the swim test if they do not swim or don't want to take the swim test, but they will also have to wear a life vest at the pool. Safety first!
- Preschool - Ages 3-4 and 5 who are not attending Kindergarten in the fall will be in camp "preschool" - they participate in most activities on campus but we run the preschool "like a preschool" where they will have center time, circle time, music time, outside time, etc - they may join the "big kids" for group activities such as morning meeting and the talent show but they are like a mini-camp inside a camp to meet their needs! Preschool students do not leave campus - they do a "splash" day on campus once or twice per week.
- Entering Kindergarten - Campers who are entering Kindergarten this coming year may opt to stay on campus or attend off-campus events - the parents must sign a paper deciding which they would like to do.
- Gear
 - Shirts - Campers must wear camp shirts each day - we recommend that you buy several!
 - Water bottles must be brought to camp daily. If your child does not bring a water bottle, your food account will be charged \$1 and he/she will be given a bottle of water. Kidcam Water bottles are available for purchase for \$10.
 - Kidcam bags are available for purchase for \$12 - they are lined to keep the wet swimsuits and towels inside the bag without leaking.
- Tuition - Best Deal by paying early for the Full Summer (but not required) (Spring Break is charged differently - you can check out those prices online in the shopping cart).
 - Full Summer - Saves you over 2 weeks tuition!! (Paid by May 9) About \$120/Week
 - Three or More Weeks - You must pay for the weeks all at one time - not at different time - and you will get 10% off the weekly rate. (paid by May 9) \$130.50/week
 - Pay by the Week as you go - \$145/week for Early Bird Price paid by Thursday at 5pm of the week prior. After 5pm on Thursday - the price for the upcoming week is \$153/week.
 - Drop In Rate is \$40/day and only available IF there is a spot - your child must wear his/her tee shirt, even if they only come one day. (If it is a field trip day or swim day, the rate is increased to \$45)
 - Spaces are limited and are on a first-come, first-served basis. No week is reserved until it has been paid in full.
- How To Get Registered:
 - Please go to our website to register! [Create an Account](#)
 - Choose "Register" if you do not have an account with us yet.
 - Fill in all the information
 - When you get ready to put items in your cart, **you will need to choose the Region as OLOM – Baton Rouge** rather than just Baton Rouge. Your camp is not open to the public, so it is not listed with the rest of the Baton Rouge region.
 - Put your registration fee, weeks, shirts, etc in the "cart" and pay online!
