

REQUIREMENTS / GUIDELINES

Little Saints (3-year-old)

A child must be three years of age before August 15th of the incoming year.

Copies of the following documents are required with the application:

- 1. Official State Birth Certificate
- 2. Certificate of Baptism (if applicable)
- 3. Immunization Record: Official State of Louisiana (or other) Universal Certificate of Immunization which includes the seal / stamp and is signed by the physician (A copy of My Chart records, etc. is not the immunization certificate).

Immunizations Required:

- 3 doses of Hep B
- 1 dose of Hep A
- 4 doses DTaP
- 3 doses polio vaccine (IPV)
- 1 dose of MMR vaccine (measles, mumps & rubella) with last dose at or after 4 years of age
- 1 dose of Varicella vaccine or documented history of the disease
- 4. Student's Social Security Card (due after an offer of admissions)
- 5. \$275 Application Fee (Payment required while submitting the application.)

Pre-Kindergarten

A child must be four years of age on or before September 30th of the incoming school year.

Copies of the following documents are required with the application:

- 1. Official State Birth Certificate
- 2. Certificate of Baptism (if applicable)
- 3. Immunization Record: Official State of Louisiana (or other) Universal Certificate of Immunization which includes the seal / stamp and is signed by the physician (A copy of My Chart records, etc. is not the immunization certificate).

Immunizations Required:

- 3 doses of Hep B
- 1 dose of Hep A
- 5 doses DTaP
- 4 doses polio vaccine (IPV) with last dose at or after 4 years of age
- 2 doses of MMR vaccine (measles, mumps & rubella) with last dose at or after 4 years of age
- 2 doses of Varicella vaccine or documented history of the disease
- 4. Student's Social Security Card (due after an offer of admissions)
- 5. \$275 Application Fee (Payment required while submitting the application.)

Kindergarten

A child must be five years of age on or before September 30th of the incoming school year.

Copies of the following documents are required with the application:

- 1. Official State Birth Certificate
- 2. Certificate of Baptism (if applicable)
- 3. Immunization Record: Official State of Louisiana (or other) Universal Certificate of Immunization which includes the seal / stamp and is signed by the physician (A copy of My Chart records, etc. is not the immunization certificate).



Immunizations Required:

- 3 doses of Hep B
- 2 doses of Hep A
- *5 doses DTaP
- **4 doses polio vaccine last dose after 4 years of age
- 2 doses of MMR vaccine (measles, mumps & rubella) with last dose at or after 4 years of age
- 2 doses of Varicella vaccine or documented history of the disease
- *Students that received their fourth dose of DTaP at age 4 or older do not need a 5th dose on record.
- **Students that received their third dose of IPV at age 4 or older do not need a fourth dose on record.
- 4. Student's Social Security Card (due after an offer of admissions)
- 5. \$275 Application Fee (Payment required while submitting the application.)

Grades 1-8

For First Grade, a child must be six years of age on or before September 30th of the incoming school year.

Copies of the following documents are required with the application:

- 1. Official State Birth Certificate
- 2. Certificate of Baptism (if applicable)
- 3. Immunization Record: Official State of Louisiana (or other) Universal Certificate of Immunization which includes the seal / stamp and is signed by the physician (A copy of My Chart records, etc. is not the immunization certificate).

Additional Immunization required at 6th grade entry or age 11:

- 1 dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MenACWY)
- 1 dose Tdap (Tetanus Diphteria Acellular Pertussis)
- 4. Student's Social Security Card (due after an offer of admissions)
- 5. Final report card from previous school
- 6. Most recent report card
- 7. Most recent standardized tests scores
- 8. FERPA Acknowledgement and Waiver Form (For Recommendation / Referral)
- 9. \$275 Application Fee (Payment required while submitting the application.)

IMMUNIZATIONS / APPLIES FOR ALL GRADE LEVELS

A student's immunizations must be up to date according to state guidelines in order to be granted admissions. During the admissions process, a parent or guardian must provide Our Lady of Mercy School with a current State Universal Certificate of Immunizations signed by the physician's office. Medical exemptions for immunizations must be documented and signed by a physician.

ADMISSIONS GUIDELINES

The following will be considered when reviewing applications for admission into Our Lady of Mercy Catholic School:

- ▶ Children who are Catholic and are currently registered parishioners at Our Lady of Mercy Church Parish
- ▶ Children who have siblings currently attending Our Lady of Mercy
- ▶ Children of alumni
- ▶ Out-of-Parish Catholic children
- ▶ Children of other faith traditions

In determining admission, the administration will review the academic, discipline and attendance records of students transferring from another school. *Please note that the Our Lady of Mercy School reserves the right to contact and obtain a recommendation from the child's previous school/center.* The administration must have a reasonable expectation of student success prior to an offer of admission. The pastor and school administration reserve the right to make final decisions on admissions.
